**ARENAS:** DRESSAGE TESTS WILL BE RIDDEN IN A STANDARD OUTDOOR ARENA WITH SAND OR IN A SMALL INDOOR. CLASSES 14-20 ARE IN A GRASS JUMP FIELD. CLASSES 12 & 13 ARE IN ≈ 100 X 200 GRASS FIELD. CLASS 21 ROAMS.

**AWARDS:** FIRST PLACE AWARDS AND RIBBONS THROUGH 6<sup>TH</sup> PLACE. CLASSES MAY BE COMBINED OR DIVIDED.

**STABLING:** LIMITED STABLING AVAILABLE ON THE GROUNDS AT \$25. PER DAY W/\$10 REFUND FOR CLEANING YOUR OWN STALL. VERY LIMITED OVERNIGHT STABLING; \$35. PRIORITY WILL BE GIVEN TO DISTANCE TRAVELED.
